THERE WILL BE A VILLAGE WIDE TRASH PICK-UP

FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 26, 2025

PLEASE DO NOT PUT ANYTHING OUT TO THE CURB BEFORE

THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 25th BE SURE TO KEEP IT SEPARATE FROM THE "WEEKLY" GARBAGE PICK-UP.

Make sure your trash is out by **6AM on September 26** because this is a **one-time pick-up**. **Once they have passed your house they will not be coming back.**

They will NOT accept

Batteries, paint, motor oil, propane tanks, Christmas trees or wreaths, brush, leaves, etc., hazardous waste.

*******NO TIRES AND NO ELECTRONICS*******

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

Refrigerators and freezers, dry paint cans, appliances (stoves, washers, dryers, etc.) Bath tubs, sinks, toilets, etc., bags of clothes, bags of toys, bedding, sofas, chairs, mattresses, box springs and metal springs. **Please limit to 2 yards per household.**

Anything refused must be removed from the curb by dark on Friday, September 26.
